Mother's Day 5K Port-a-Pot Decorating Guidelines:

- Decorations must be removable and not mar the surface. Clear packing tape works well to secure decorations.
- Approximate overall dimensions are 2'8" wide by 6'5" tall. The door area is approximately 2'2" by 5'6" with recessed handle on right.
- Some do just the door; others add inside decor. It's up to you!
- Decorating window opens at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday and must be completed by 7:00 a.m. on Sunday for judging.
- You will be emailed a Port-a-Pot-Bib to attach to the front of your Port-a-Pot building to identify you for the contest.
- Prizes will be awarded to Top Adult (19+) and Top Youth (18 & under) after the race. If you cannot be present, the prize will be mailed.
